John 12:46 I have come as a light into the world, that whoever believes in Me should not abide in darkness. 47 And if anyone hears My words and does not believe, I do not judge him; for I did not come to judge the world but to SAVE THE WORLD.

John 3:16 For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. 17 God sent his Son into the world not to judge the world, but to SAVE THE WORLD through Him. 18 "There is no judgment against anyone who believes in him. But anyone who does not believe in him has already been judged for not believing in God's one and only Son. 19 And the judgment is based on this fact: God's light came into the world, but people loved the darkness more than the light, for their actions were evil. 20 All who do evil hate the light and refuse to go near it for fear their sins will be exposed. 21 But those who do what is right come to the light so others can see that they are doing what God wants."

### 🕒 WHAT IS THE FULL GOSPEL?

Romans 15: 19 They were convinced by the power of miraculous signs and wonders and by the power of God's Spirit. In this way, I have fully presented and preached the Gospel Good News of Christ from Jerusalem all the way to Illyricum.

🕒 vs. 18 - "Convinced" [became believers, followers, etc.] by obedience - to compliance, surrender or submit to observing following Christ; Obeying is a tremendous power that is a Tool in the Relating to ppl, Saving lives, and Supernatural. Obedience is the act of Trusting God.

🕒 Power of dynamis- miraculous signs and wonders and the power of The Holy Spirit. ALERT! This definition of dynamic is the Power for miracles and MORAL EXCELLENCE!

🕒 You could be saying, "I believe it is the Gospel "Jesus Christ" that Saves. True. Notice what it written here... fully presented and preached the Gospel Good News of Christ.

🕒 This is The Full Gospel - (not so many seminars or books or traditional seminaries teaching this...?)

20 My ambition has always been to preach the Good News where the name of Christ has never been heard (or known), so that I would not build upon another's foundation where a church has already been started by someone else.

🕒 Our evangelism should be targeting...

1. Unsaved,
2. Unchurched, &
3. New to Town

🕒 Because our purpose and plan is NOT for church transference, but rather accepting gift of eternal life, being born again, and being saved all for the first time or returning to Jesus by Mercy Strategy and Moving with Compassion.

21 I have been following the plan spoken of in the Scriptures, where it say, "Those who have never been told about him will see, and those who have never heard of him will understand."

🕒 This is our evangelistic plan.

🕒 This is why we are sharing being Supernatural in Services and Streets.

🕒 I pray this is literally being Preached and Talked through from the Truths of Texts in The Word of God

22 In fact, my visit to you has been delayed so long because I have been preaching in these places.

### John 12: 25-34; 46-47

25 Those who love their life in this world will lose it. Those who care nothing for their life in this world will keep it for eternity. 26 Anyone who wants to serve me must follow me, because my servants must be where I am. And the Father will honor anyone who serves me.

27 "Now my soul is deeply troubled. Should I pray, 'Father, save me from this hour'? But this is the very reason I came! 28 Father, bring glory to your name."

Then a voice spoke from heaven, saying, "I have already brought glory to my name, and I will do so again." 29 When the crowd heard the voice, some thought it was thunder, while others declared an angel had spoken to him.

30 Then Jesus told them, "The voice was for your benefit, not mine. 31 The time for judging this world has come, when Satan, the ruler of this world, will be cast out. 32 And when I am lifted up from the earth, I will draw everyone to myself." 33 He said this to indicate how he was going to die.

34 The crowd responded, "We understood from Scripture that the Messiah would live forever. How can you say the Son of Man will die? Just who is this Son of Man, anyway?"

- 🕒 We must stop coming to church, and become the church.
- 🕒 What if we laid down our lives, that someone else could lived?
- 🕒 JOY is a CORE muscle to The Kingdom and in community.

## Let us Study the Scriptures

**James 1:** 2 Dear brothers and sisters, when troubles of any kind come your way, consider it an opportunity for great joy. 3 For you know that when your faith is tested, your endurance has a chance to grow. 4 So let it grow, for when your endurance is fully developed, you will be perfect and complete, needing nothing.

### Turn to John 13

- 🕒 We want to capture two JOYS of JESUS
- 🕒 Sacrificially Serve one another as HE Served us
- 🕒 Love one another as HE Loved us; & in vs.1- Jesus loved them until the end, so we must love one another to the end

**Hebrews 12:** 1Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a huge crowd of witnesses to the life of faith, let us strip off every weight that slows us down, especially the sin that so easily trips us up. And let us run with endurance the race God has set before us. 2We do this by keeping our eyes on Jesus, (looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.) the champion who initiates and perfects our faith. Because of the joy awaiting him, he endured the cross, disregarding its shame. Now he is seated in the place of honor beside God's throne. 3Think of all the hostility he endured from sinful people; then you won't become weary and give up.

### Genesis 22: 1-14

John 8: 56 Your father Abraham rejoiced to see My day, and he saw it and was glad."

Hebrews 11: 17It was by faith that Abraham offered Isaac as a sacrifice when God was testing him. Abraham, who had received God's promises, was ready to sacrifice his only son, Isaac, 18even though God had told him, "Isaac is the son through whom your descendants will be counted." 19Abraham reasoned that if Isaac died, God was able to bring him back to life again. And in a sense, Abraham did receive his son back from the dead.
