- We value **The Person of The Holy Spirit Who is sent to live in and lead us.**
- John 14: 16 And I will ask the Father, and He will give you another [Gr Paracletos, one called alongside to help.] Helper (Comforter, Advocate, Intercessor—Counselor, Strengtheners, Standby), to be with you forever— 17 the Spirit of Truth, whom the world cannot receive [and take to its heart] because it does not see Him or know Him, but you know Him because He (the Holy Spirit) remains with you continually and will be in you. 18 “I will not leave you as orphans [comfortless, bereaved, and helpless]; I will come [back] to you. 23 Jesus answered and said to him, “If anyone loves Me, he will keep My word; and My Father will love him, and We will come to him and make Our home with him.
- We are **God’s children: sons & daughters who are led by HIS Spirit.**
- “Therefore there is now no condemnation [no guilty verdict, no punishment] for those who are in Christ Jesus [who believe in Him as personal Lord and Savior]. For all who are led by the Spirit of God are children of God.” -Romans 8:1, 14
- We live with **God’s power in us.**
- “But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you. And you will be my witnesses, telling people about me everywhere—in Jerusalem, throughout Judea, in Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.” -Acts 1:8.
- We are **Led by the Spirit**, not by the law of Moses.
- Galatians 5: 16 But I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh. 17 For the desires of the flesh (sinful nature) are against the Spirit, and the desires of the Spirit are against the flesh, for these are opposed to each other, to keep you from doing the things you want to do. 18 But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law. — *led away from the flesh, law, & legalism of wrong*
- NLT vs.17 The sinful nature wants to do evil, which is just the opposite of what the Spirit wants. And the Spirit gives us desires that are the opposite of what the sinful nature desires. **These two forces are constantly fighting each other,** so you are not free to carry out your good intentions.

Ammunition -

1. supply or quantity of bullets & shells;
2. information that can be used to attack or defend a claim or argument or viewpoint

flesh -

1. denotes mere human nature, the earthly nature of man apart from divine influence, and therefore prone to sin and opposed to God
2. symbol of what is external, or as the means of kindred), or (by implication) human nature (with its frailties (physically or morally) and passions), or (specially), a human being (as such):—carnal(-ly, + -ly minded), flesh(-ly)

= Character of Christ

The evidence of my conversion is that i do not live according to the carnal desires, fleshy values; natural nature separated from God. - I want to invite you to an incredibly relevant read, an actual text I received this week.
- Please do not shy back from finding tendencies that may describe you. Consider the context of the scriptures and how Paul is speaking to the church at Galatia believers, deceivers, misleaders, backsliders, “needers.”

- Traditional Translation - Galatians 5:19-21. Then, The Message Bible
- My text said, “ This translation cuts to the core like I haven’t seen in a while! Had to reread it a few times” 19-21 It is obvious what kind of life develops out of trying to get your own way all the time: repetitive, loveless, cheap sex; a stinking accumulation of mental and emotional garbage; frenzied and joyless grabs for happiness; trinket gods; magic-show religion; paranoid loneliness; cutthroat competition; all-consuming-yet-never-satisfied wants; a brutal temper; an impotence to love or be loved; divided homes and divided lives; small-minded and lopsided pursuits; the vicious habit of depersonalizing everyone into a rival; uncontrolled and uncontrollable addictions; ugly parodies of community. I could go on. This isn’t the first time I have warned you, you know. If you use your freedom this way, you will not inherit God’s kingdom.

- Why Does Love Dominate?
- Romans 14:17
- Fruit of Long-suffering which is Patience = R* The patience of God! 2 Peter 3:15
- When we speak of the patience of God, we are not talking about enduring hard times; we are talking about being longsuffering toward people.
- The Hebrew word is often translated, "slow to anger." The Hebrew word is arek. The word arek appears about fifteen times in the Old Testament and sometimes it says "longsuffering," sometimes "patience," or sometimes "slow to anger." It means "patient," as in "slow."
- In the New Testament the word "patient," like a lot of our English translations, changes it into "longsuffering" or makrothumeo, which is used about twenty-five times. It means "taking a long time to boil." God is slow-the patience of God.
- In 2 Peter 3, it is going to tell us about future events. It is going to tell us how the world order is going to be changed and how Jesus Christ is going to come back to earth and set up a new kingdom. The theme, however, is patience. It is longsuffering,
- Galatians 5:24-25 and John 15: 4-11, 16-17.

If we live by the Spirit, let us also walk by the Spirit.
